In the coming weeks, we have some important events planned. Most of them can be found in other places in the Beacon, but just in case you don't make it past the first page . . .

• Sunday, May 5, 11:10 AM - Noon: Immediately following service we'll have a Town Hall meeting to discuss the unhoused/homeless situation in our community. We'll be joined by local expert Aurora William, who manages our winter Warming Center, talk about how homelessness affects our church, and have a time for Q&A (including the opportunity to submit anonymous questions). Please join us for fellowship, snacks, and conversation.

• Friday, May 10, 6PM-8PM: Pasta Dinner and Talent Show Fundraiser, to improve the media capabilities in our sanctuary. Sign-up to bring a sauce, salad, or dessert, and to share your talent. And definitely buy some raffle tickets; we have prizes you won't want to miss! This promises to be a fun night, but we need *you* here to make it the best it can be.

• Friday and Saturday, May 24-25, 8AM-3PM: Estate Sale in Plymouth Hall. Last year was a huge success, and we're about to do it again. 


"Strengthen the Church – Strengthen Our Church" special mission offering, begins May 19th: The Strengthen the Church special mission offering is taken each year by UCC churches, which begins on Pentecost Sunday, May 19th. This offering supports UCC churches for leadership development, new churches, youth ministry, and innovation in existing congregations to promote their stability. As done previously, Plymouth Church will keep half of this year's offering to support the growth and stability of our church thereby making this offering "Strengthen the Church – Strengthen Our Church." Our current need continues to be to help defray significant projected facilities expenses in the coming years. Please plan to give as you are able to support UCC churches and the growth and stability of Plymouth Church. Donations may be by check payable to Plymouth Church with a notation for "STC" or by using the Strengthen the Church offering envelopes.

The Plymouth Cares meal on April 2nd served a record 106 dinners at the ECHO Paso shelter. Eleven people prepared this meal. Melinda organized the main dish of delicious beef enchiladas and prepared them with Alex, Becky, Stu and Linda. Since each of the 106 dinners had two enchiladas, Melinda and crew created 212 enchiladas! The appetizing sides were green salad with Ranch dressing by John S., buttered Hawaiian sweet rolls by John and Linda T., and chocolate chip cookies provided by Alison. The PBJ sack lunch crew was John & Carlie S., Nikol, Olivia and Linda. The cheerful servers at the shelter were Melinda, Stu, John T., and John S. It was a great day to do God's work for the unhoused and hungry, and to enjoy each other's wonderful company. The next Plymouth Cares meal is May 7th, with helpers always needed and appreciated.

One Great Hour of Sharing (OGHS) update: This UCC special mission offering was taken back on March 10th, and raised a wonderful \$605. OGHS sends support for advocacy, sustainable development, refugee and asylum issues, migration, disasters, and assisting those most in need and vulnerable among us. We are making a difference to help our brothers and sisters in need, by *Sharing the Light*.

The box for Donations for the Unhoused provided a wonderful assortment of blouses/shirts, assorted toiletries and a new pair of ladies shoes. <u>Our PCC Youth Group is continuing their Care Kits ministry</u> and checking the box for any travel-size items that can be placed in large baggies, including toothbrushes, toothpaste, dental floss, soap, shampoo, deodorant, feminine hygiene products, new socks, lotion, sunscreen, lip balm, new combs/brushes, nail clippers, disposable razors, and shaving cream. Of course, we are always looking for the other items on the list attached to the box. Thank you for the donations already received.

The Mission-Outreach Team needs more members on its board. With only four members on our board, we need additional people to help us plan and develop our outreach activities to our community and beyond.
